HIGHLIGHTS:

- Ensuring accurate diagnosis from GI tract biopsies requires adequate clinical information, optimal sample collection techniques including multiple biopsies from precise sites, and careful handling.
- Pathological interpretation presents challenges such as distinguishing normal immune cells from inflammation and managing disease heterogeneity, necessitating integration of biopsy results with clinical context and other findings.

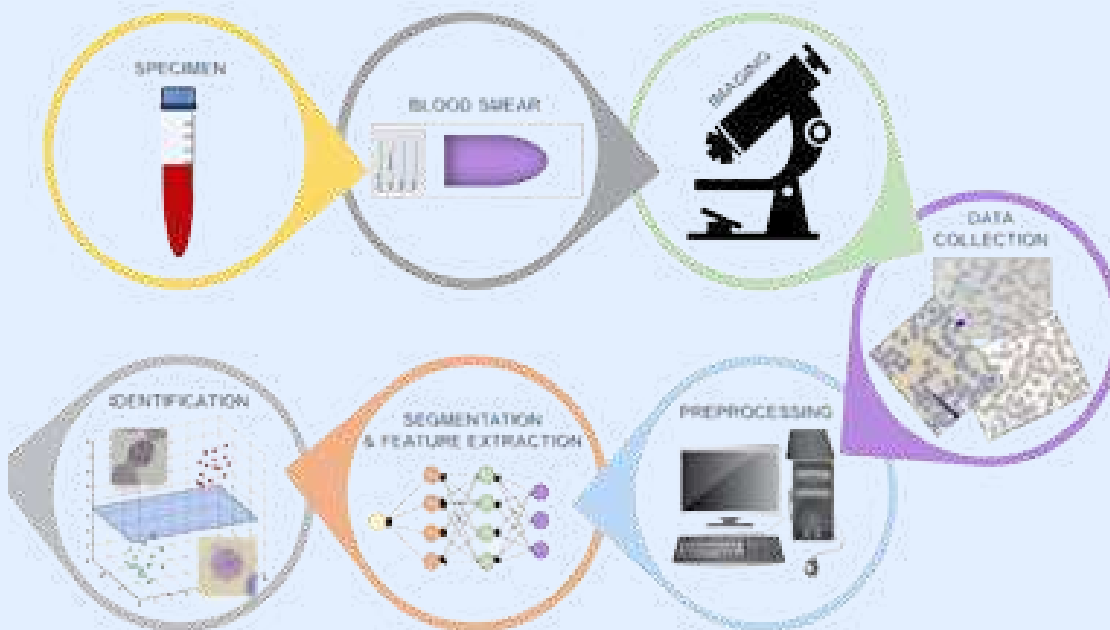
