Excessive and prolonged noise exposure is a public health concern causing preventable hearing loss. This session explores the various aspects of hearing conservation—from understanding the hidden impact of noise-induced hearing impairment to implementing effective preventive strategies such as noise risk assessment, engineering and administrative controls, safe listening practices, regular hearing screening, and awareness initiatives. Together, these topics aim to create a culture of hearing health by equipping participants with the knowledge to prevent noise-related hearing damage across occupational and community settings.
